RULES OF RACING

Welcome to the Champion System Criteriums conducted by Easts Cycling Club under the rules & policies of Cycling NSW

The following notes explain the concept of the race and outline some of the policies which apply to Tuesday night racing

Racing starts at 6pm and is a graded handicap with 3 grades, A, B and C.

- B grade start race first, followed by B1 (if numbers allow)
- C grade start second @ approx 45sec
- A grade start last @ approx 1min 30sec
- Time gaps are determined on the night based on number of riders, strength of each bunch and weather conditions.
- C grade lead the race until caught by B grade and A grade the 2nd time
- The object of the race is for all 3 grades to come together in the closing 3 laps

The annual Easts Trophy Race event on 15 December is 2 separate races for A/B1 (20laps scratch) and B/C grade (15laps handicap)

Race Entry

- All riders MUST have a valid CA Race licence.
- Race Entry is \$20 cash on the night exact amount no change
- Race numbers will be issued and kept by each rider for the season.
- Sign on opens 5pm all riders **MUST** sign on prior to race start.
- If you have never raced at Tuesday Night Heffron please register at www.eastscycling.com.au/registration
- Race Handicapper and Race Manager will have final decision on grading of riders.
- Riders returning from illness/injury or who have been absent from racing for any length of time cannot enter a grade lower than their normal grade.

Specific regulations to note are

- Please **REMOVE** all pumps, lights from your bike before racing
- Club apparel or NSW approved sponsor apparel to be worn
- Race numbers are to be worn on the **RIGHT** side of the jersey.
- Riders may have a lap out for a mechanical/puncture but MUST race the last 3 laps
- Lapped riders are not permitted to join a slower grade and must leave the circuit if dropped

All riders must follow the directions of the Race Commissaire who will have the final decision in any disputes that may arise.

Prizemoney/Results

Each week \$850 prizemoney is distributed

1 st Overall	\$300
2 nd Overall	\$200
3 rd Overall	\$100

1 st unplaced Grade	\$100 (not in the top 3)
1 st unplaced Grade	\$100 (not in the top 3)

1st Female rider \$50

Champion System Jackpot POOL


Champion Systems are giving a Jackpot of \$1000 for 10 races - **\$50** to the 2 losing grades each week

• If A grade win overall, then B and C grade will have \$50 added to their prizemoney for the following race, or vice versa if B or C grade win overall

Tuesday Night Race Tips

Heffron Park during the summer is one of the windiest places in Sydney.

- Understand where the wind is before the race
- Ride safely out of the wind
- Roll turns into the wind
- Don't chop other riders on the inside
- Always follow the pace line

Sydney summer weather patterns can be very unpredictable and unless there is persistent, heavy rain racing will go ahead

A weather call will be made no later than 3pm if racing is cancelled and published on the Heffron Park Tuesday Night Racing facebook page.
